

# HOMEWORK POLICY

## PURPOSE

To outline to our school community the Department's and Vermont South Special School's policy requirements relating to homework.

## SCOPE

This policy applies to students in all year levels and staff responsible for setting and monitoring homework at Vermont South Special School.

#### RATIONALE

- providing opportunities for students to review, revise and reinforce newly acquired skills
- fostering good lifelong learning and study habits
- supporting learning partnerships with parents/carers.

#### POLICY

- Homework will be consistent across the school. The take-home reading program will be offered from Foundation throughout students' primary years.
- Accompanying documents for homework will be consistent, such as, guidelines for parent/carers and reading logs.
- The take-home reading program needs to be appropriate to the child. For example, students' that are pre-readers will be supported through a program consisting of an alternation between alphabet, word work and simple texts.
- Students will take home books at a level lower than their instructional reading level. This enables reading at home to be an enjoyable experience and the opportunity for practise of reading strategies taught at school.
- Students that are able to read independently may do so, rather than aloud with their parent/carer. Following reading, a discussion of the text with the parent/carer will be encouraged.
- Opportunities for readers to be changed during the morning routine will be offered daily, as they are returned.
- Parents and carers will be invited to attend a reading information session so they can better understand reading development and feel more equipped to support their child's reading at home.
- Therapists will provide homework tasks as required to reinforce their programs.
- If a family requests further homework, the classroom teacher and Curriculum Leader will work together to provide this.

#### SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS/CARERS

Vermont South Special School understands that students have different learning strengths, preferences and interests and may approach learning activities and homework differently. If parents/carers are concerned their child may not understand the homework tasks that have been set or is spending a long period of time completing their homework, we encourage parents/carers to speak to their child's teacher.
